

UniSIM-STU Sponsorship (January 2011 Intake)

Application Intake: January 2011

Admission & Sponsorship Campaign Period: 18 August to 30 September 2010

The UniSIM-STU Sponsorship applications are now open from 18 August to 30 September 2010 for January 2011 intake. Members who meet the admission criteria can select from a wide range of degree programmes offered by UniSIM under the four schools – Arts & Social Science, Business, Human Development & Social Services and Science & Technology.

Who is eligible?

The Sponsorship is open to all STU members who have **at least 6 months' of continuous paid up union membership**. In addition, applicants should be Singapore citizens or permanent residents with good academic and co-curricular activities record, strong language skills, and who demonstrate leadership qualities and not already be a degree holder.

Value of Sponsorship

- 1) Singapore Citizens who are eligible for government subsidy – award will cover 70% of the total course fee (inclusive of government subsidy).
- 2) Singapore Permanent Residents who are eligible for government subsidy – award will cover 60% of the total course fee (inclusive of government subsidy).
- 3) Students who are not eligible for government subsidy – award will cover 50% of the total course fee.

There is no bond attached to the sponsorship.
